Photo Contest Themes 2016

Month	Themes	Description		
1.	Shrimps, Crabs, Lobster	Just like it says look it up in the book (crabs, shrimp, lobsters, etc.). When in doubt Wikipedia can help you out.		
2.	Black & White	Mono-color images (black & white, sepia, bluetone, etc.). Only shades of or color are allowed. Can be taken as a monocolor image straight out of the cera or edited down from full color.		
3.	Toadfish, Scorpionfish, Lizardfish	A group of Odd-shaped bottom dwellers. Normally found resting on the sea tom. All are consisted experts at camouflage		
4.	Something Striped	A critter or fish that has noticeable stripes. A long narrow band distinguished, as by color or texture, from the surrounding material or surface		
5.	Curves	Anything that is characterized by a curve. Can be fish, invertebrates, or even non-living. To have or take a turn, change, or deviation from a straight line or plane surface without sharp breaks or angularity		
5a Video	General	1 to 3 minutes		
6.	Barracuda, Tarpon, Spadefish	A group of fish ranging in color from silver to gray. May have a bluish, yellowish or greenish tints. In this theme we are only dealing with 3 types.		
7.	Eyes	Any sea life that has an eye. Can be fish, invertebrates or mammal.		
8.	Echinoderms (starfish of all kinds, urchins, sea cucumbers, etc.)			
9.	Textures	Texture, another element of art, is used to describe either the way a three- dimensional work actually feels when touched, or the visual "feel" of a two- dimensional work.		
10.	Wild Faces	The face is front part of the head that extends from the forehead to the chin and includes the mouth, nose, cheeks, and eyes. The wild is going beyond normal or conventional bounds.		
10a Video	General	1 to 3 minutes		
11.	Hogfish, Wrasses, Parrotfish, Razorfish	A group of fish that have pectoral fins with large, even scales.		
12.	Best of HUPS	NOVICE, INTERMEDIATE, ADVANCED, and CREATIVE contests: First place winners from each month's Novice, Intermediate, and Advanced of gories will be entered automatically for judging. The Creative category lets you enter anything you want as long as you do the photography and any special editing.

Changes and Reminders for the HUPS 2016 Photo/ Video Contests

Changes:

1. The photo entry deadline day has been changed to the Wed 11:59 pm before the monthly meeting date. Reason for the change is to give the photo coordinator time to review the entries before submitting them for judging. This also allows the judges' time to judge the entries during the week days rather than on a weekend. Note this deadline is the last day your can submit entries early submissions are always welcome.

2. Video contest entries – The club wants to continue making progress on the video contest we started in 2015. To accomplish that goal the video contest will be scheduled for entries in the months of May and October.

Length of video accepted: 1 to 3 minutes Subject: Must underwater or diving related Content: Can include stills along with video

Format: Mp4, AVI and MOV

Deadline: Same as the Photo Contest

Filename: First initial and Last Name_x x= the number of your entry Submissions will be to the Club's Dropbox because of the file size.

3. Email address for submitting your entries is hupsphotocontest@gmail.com the email systems will response with a message letting you know that your entry was received.

Reminders

- 1. If your entry has been a winner in a previous contest it will be disqualified. Remember this is a photography hobby contest and it just for fun.
- 2. The submitted photographs should be sized to 1920×1080 and 72 dpi. Note if you are using light room the crop setting 16x9 is 1920×1080 .


